109. Chairman's Announcements

- The transfer of USRA land to PC will soon be completed.
- The container behind the hall will be replaced due to the bad condition of the current one.

110. Open Session for Members of the Public to Raise Relevant Matters.

- The privately owned tree which fell onto a garage on Westminster Drive and implications concerning insurance were discussed. A further 2 privately owned trees, needing possible removal due to disease, were also discussed. Cllr Georgia Moore is to meet with Council Officer Tom Pettit (RBC) and residents to address these concerns.
- A possible Neighbourhood Watch Scheme, to be set up by residents, was raised after the theft of a car from a resident's driveway. NWS are community led and not Parish Council run.
- A resident was pleased with the result of the negotiated monetary reduction between DWH and the PC concerning the land handover.
- A resident thanked the PC and all volunteers and asked what further help the community could offer (agenda item for the next meeting).
- The co-option of new councillors was confirmed.
- A resident asked if the draft minutes could be published more quickly in order for information to be shared with residents asap after meetings.
